VA PAUMCS Experience Your Conference Connection 2019

Your VA PAUMCS invites you to our fall event: Experience Your Conference Connection 2019, Wednesday, October 30, 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Virginia United Methodist Center 10330 Staples Mill Road, Glen Allen, VA 23058.Attendees who participate in all sessions will earn .5 CEU (continuing education units).

Our speakers for the event are Chris Malak and MaryKaye Cochran, members of the Conference Center staff. Chris Malak will give an overview of the new data plan for the Conference, showing how church data is collected and used. He'll explain the plan currently underway to improve this, and show how the changes will impact persons at the church level. MaryKaye Cochran will facilitate an interactive presentation on MissionInsite, a website that provides access to a great quantity of demographic information about your community. We will look at the reports MissionInsite can generate as well as Mosaic segments which provide detailed information about folks' religious perspectives, worship preferences, key behaviors, and much more. Bring your laptop or tablet so you can manipulate the website as MaryKaye walks you through its different components.

Chris Malak is the Virginia Conference's new Database Manager. Prior to joining the VA Conference, he spent over 12 years in the software development industry. Over that time, he held nearly every position within the software development life cycle, from requirements gathering, architecture, project management, development, quality assurance, installation, and support. His specialty is Business Intelligence, a subset of software devoted to the storing, querying, and presentation of information in an actionable format for stakeholders to make decisions. He holds an undergraduate degree in Computer Science and a Master's in Business Administration. Chris and his family live in Richmond.

MaryKaye Cochran is the administrative assistant for the Center for Congregational Excellence since April 2, 2018. The Center is responsible for new faith community development and church revitalization. Prior to joining the VA Conference, MaryKaye served as

the Director of Discipleship at Woodlake UMC for 12 years. She has also been on staff at Farmville UMC and Duncan Memorial UMC. Prior to her positions in Christian Education, she worked at Longwood College (now University) for 12 years. The General Council on Finance and Administration (GCFA) of The United Methodist Church sponsors an online certification institute. The institute provides outstanding advanced professional training and enrichment for United Methodist church administrators. A participant who completes the program and meets the requirements set forth by the GCFA is eligible to apply for certification as a *Professional United*



Methodist Church Administrator. The class for 2019 has ended, but <u>now</u> is the time to plan for 2020. As budgets and work schedules are prepared for next year, start having conversations with your church leadership on how your church can support your certification efforts. The course is designed to be self-paced. Each participant has 2 months (usually in the summer) to complete the course work and group project. There is also the opportunity to receive Advanced Certification which is a three-day in-person training in Nashville. More information Advanced Certification can be found at: PAUMCS Advanced
Certification. No dates for the next class are available yet.
